

Augmentative & Alternative Communication

The Children's Care Rehabilitation Center offers thorough Augmentative Communication and Computer access evaluations using the latest technology.

The clinic is staffed by our specialized, experienced team of speech-language pathologists, occupational therapists, an educator with a master's degree in educational technology, and South Dakota's only therapists (3) certified as Assistive Technology Practitioners (ATP) by the Rehabilitation Engineering and Assistive Technology Society of North America (RESNA).

Evaluation

- Through intake information and interview, we develop goals and objectives specific for each client. This determines the direction of the evaluation.
- The speech-language pathologist evaluates the client to determine each individual's communication ability and communication needs.
- Initial evaluation determines which types of communication methods will be examined. These methods range from simple picture symbol or word board devices, low-tech speech output

devices and high tech devices with virtually unlimited speech output vocabulary.

- The individual's access methods are also assessed as part of the communication device trial. Access methods range from direct finger access to eye-gaze or switch access using nearly any body movement.
- Computer access evaluation can occur as part of the augmentative communication evaluation or as a separate evaluation. The computer specialist selects from a wide array of adapted software and hardware to meet the computing needs of the individual. The access methods range from adapted keyboards and mouse devices to voice activation, switch access or direct access using state of the art methods that can track head or eye movement.
- Recommendations are documented as part of a written comprehensive report based on clinical findings.

Follow-up

- Training sessions for new users may be scheduled following delivery of the equipment.
- Follow-up visits are encouraged to determine how the system is working and if any changes need to be made.
